About

Eco-birthday programs at Glen Helen are for ages 4 to 12 and include:

- A private party space for up to 25 people for two hours
- Party room set up with tables, chairs, green table coverings, and "Happy Birthday" banner
- One hour of leader-led nature activities including a live animal encounter and an outdoor activity AND one hour free for cake, gifts, etc.
- Additional add-ons available

Cost

- \$250 for up to 25 people including attending parents.
- \$200 for space rental only with no activities included.
- A \$50 deposit is due at the time of booking. The balance is due ONE week prior to the event date.
- In the event of cancellation, the \$50 deposit is non-refundable.

Policies

- Maximum of 25 people including attending parents. At least 2 parents must be present for the duration of the event.
- Dress for the weather. All programs include an outdoor component. In the case of poor conditions, alternate indoor activities will be provided.
- Food and drink are permitted.
- To protect wildlife, balloons, pinatas, confetti, and glitter are not permitted.
- Alcohol and smoking are not permitted.
- Trash and recyclables must be disposed of in the bins provided.

Amazing Animals (all seasons)
