Dear Future Leaders,

Thank you for your interest in Glen Helen Ecocamp's Leaders in Training (LIT) Program. We believe that the summer camp experience is one of the most valuable experiences a young person can have. Our hope is that your time as an Ecocamper has been significant in your life. Individuals who apply to be an LIT are those who wish to give back to the tradition and culture of this special place and are prepared to take their own knowledge and leadership skills to the next level.

To Apply:

1. Please write a letter explaining (1) What Ecocamp means to you and (2) What you hope to accomplish or develop during your time as an LIT and (3) What your future plans are at this time and how the LIT program will help prepare you for those endeavors.
2. Ask someone who is not related to you, but who knows you well; a coach, scoutmaster, pastor, or teacher for example, to serve as a character reference for you. They should be able to speak to your personal and professional qualities that would make you a good candidate for our program. Take some time to meet with them in person and discuss the things you mentioned in your application letter with them so that they fully understand this opportunity and what you're interested in achieving. We will contact this person for a reference via an email address or phone number that you must include in your application.

4. Register for Ecocamp's Leader in Training session online and make your deposit to secure the camp.
5. Once your application materials have been submitted, you will be contacted to schedule an interview.
